YOUR ROLE

Your work will fit into the range of our philanthropic activities:

- **Define an impact strategy**: support our clients in developing an impact objective that is both ambitious and realistic and translate this objective into a strategy and a concrete roadmap. This work is based on an in-depth analysis of both the area of impact (e.g., inclusion, agroecology, access to culture, etc.) and national and international best practices.
- Source and select non-profit projects as part of clients' impact strategy: develop an overview of the impact area in question, and a vision of relevant structures to support for our clients. It also involves carrying out due diligence to confirm the viability of these projects before recommendation.
- Ensure monitoring of supported projects: establish support agreements with clear impact objectives, support projects in their operations and in their problematic situations where applicable, monitor the progress of projects and report to the client.
- Occasionally, participate in **in-depth analysis** on impact topics: research, documentary analysis, expert meetings.
- Live and embody the values and culture of Telos Impact daily.
